

Herkimer Diamond Mines 57 minutes (38.3 miles)







World Famous Herkimer Diamonds are beautiful, fun to find, and the whole family can dig for them. Actually quartz crystals, the stones were faceted by nature half a billion years ago. You keep everything you find, so grab your goggles and hammer and start digging for diamonds! Herkimer Diamonds are beautiful double-terminated quartz crystals found in Herkimer, New York. The crystals are magnificent works of nature, found in the rock, having a diamond-like geometrical shape.

Northeast Classic Car Museum 39 minutes (25.6 miles)





The Northeast Classic Car Museum collects, preserves, interprets, and exhibits vehicles related to the evolution of transportation, with particular emphasis on the role of the automobile and its impact on American Culture. Over 170 vehicles from 1899 through the early 1980's are on display in five connected buildings. Exhibits feature pre-war and post-war vehicles, the world's largest collection of Franklins, and cars made in NY State.
